Did you know?

Portmeirion is one of the most picturesque spots in the whole of Wales and was designed by renowned architect Sir Clough Williams-Ellis who, in the early 1900s, set about bringing his vision of an Italian-inspired village to life in the form of Portmeirion.

The grade II listed Grand Hotel in Scarborough took 4 years to build, officially opening its doors in 1867. The building cost approximately £100,000 which equates to over £11 million in today's money. The hotel consists of 4 towers to represent the 4 seasons, 12 floors to signify each month within the year, 52 chimneys to denote the weeks of the year and 365 rooms to symbolise each day of the year.
