







Famous people from South America, can you name them?













1.FRIDA KAHLO

Magdalena Carmen Frida Kahlo y Calderón was a Mexican painter known for her many portraits, self-portraits and works inspired by the nature and artifacts of Mexico.

2. FIDEL CASTRO

Fidel Alejandro Castro Ruz was a Cuban revolutionary and politician who was the leader of Cuba from 1959 to 2008, serving as the prime minister of Cuba from 1959 to 1976 and president from 1976 to 2008.

3. PELE

Edson Arantes do Nascimento, better known by his nickname Pelé, was a Brazilian professional footballer who played as a forward. Widely regarded as one of the greatest players of all time, he was among the most successful and popular sports figures of the 20th century.

4. EVA PERON

María Eva Duarte de Perón, better known as just Eva Perón or by the nickname Evita, was an Argentine politician, activist, actress and philanthropist who served as First Lady of Argentina from June 1946 until her death in July 1952, as the wife of Argentine President Juan Domingo Perón.

- 5. AUGUSTO PINOCHET was the president of the Chilean Military Junta from 1973 to 1981.
- 6. YMA SÚMAC was an exotica artist. Yma was a Peruvian soprano. She was one of the most famous proponents of exotica music in the 1950s. She became an international success based on her extreme vocal range. It was said to be 'over four octaves' and was sometimes claimed to span even five octaves at her peak.
