Burns Night

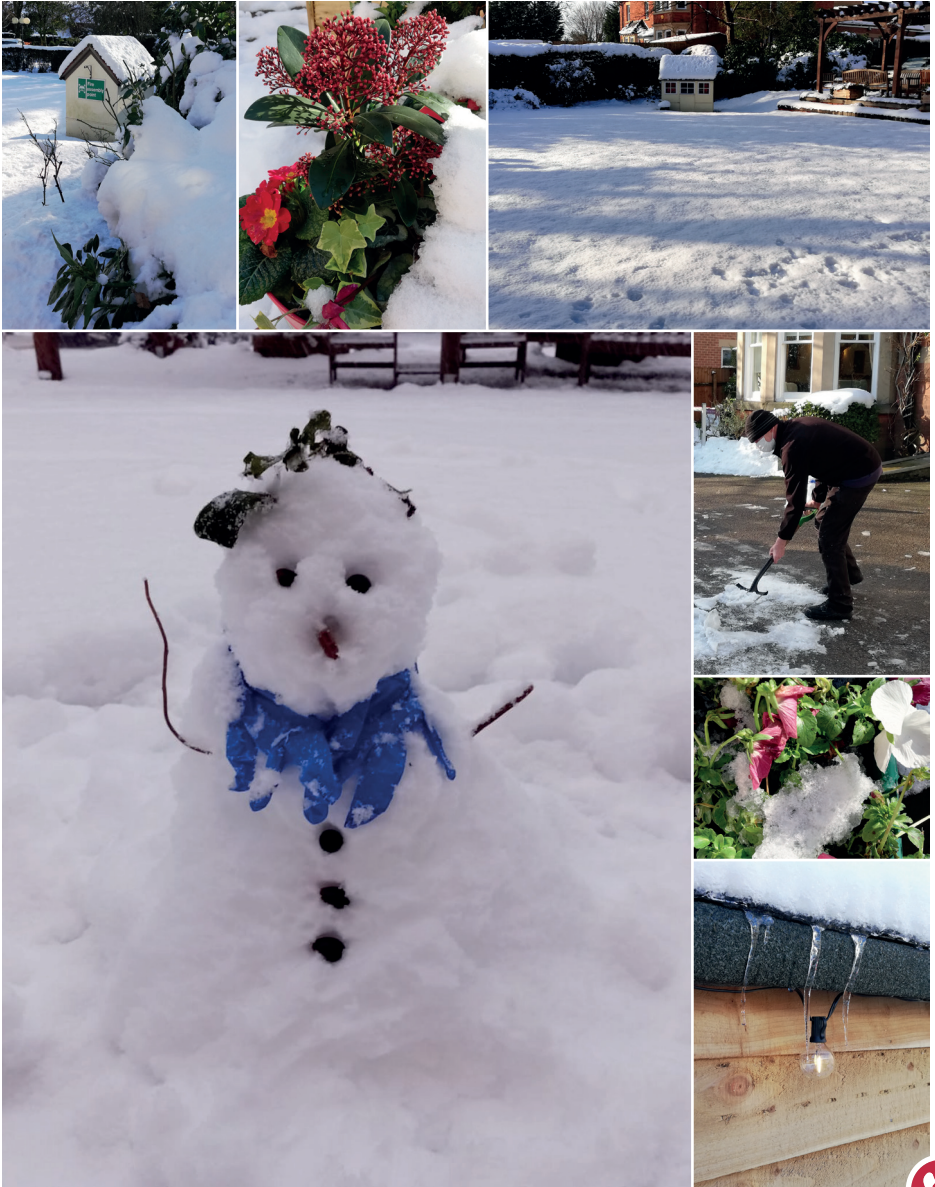
